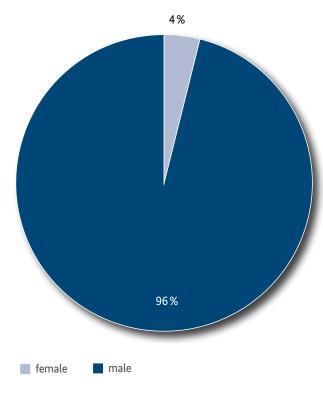

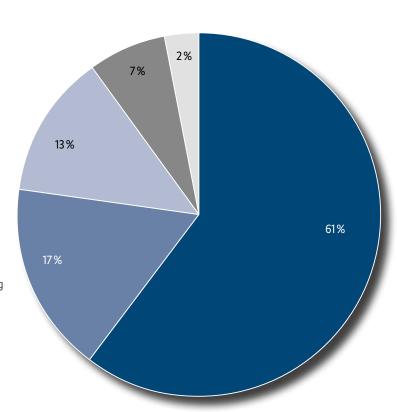

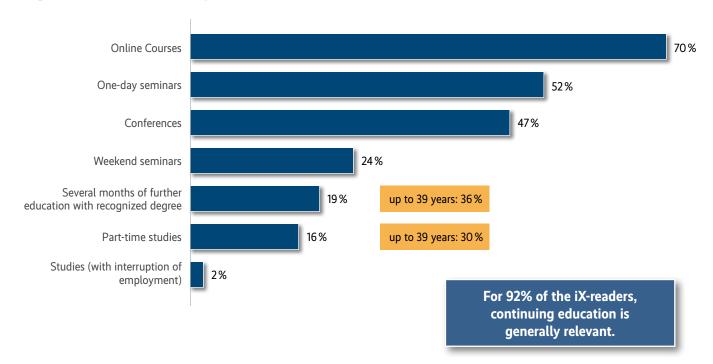

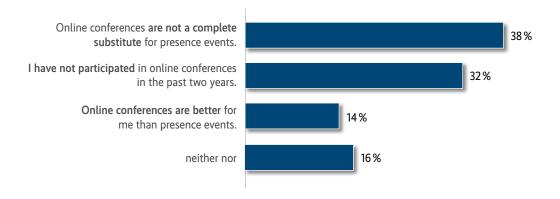


Question: "Which of the following forms of continung vocational training do you have a general interest in?" (multiple answers possible)

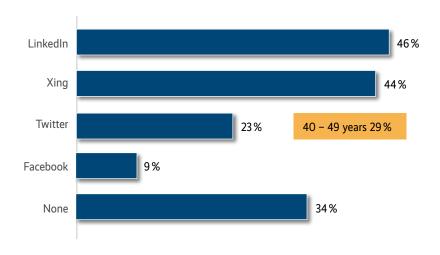

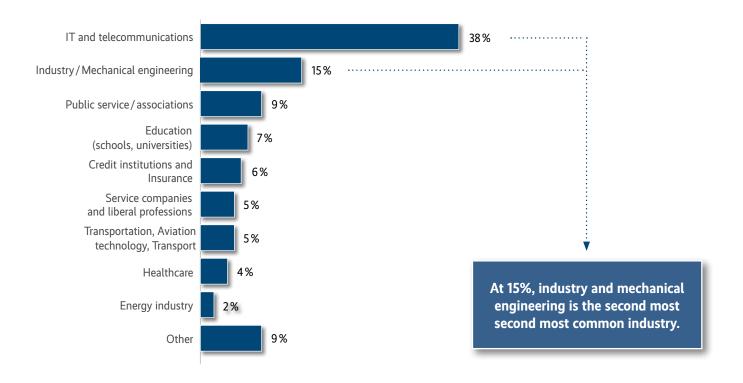

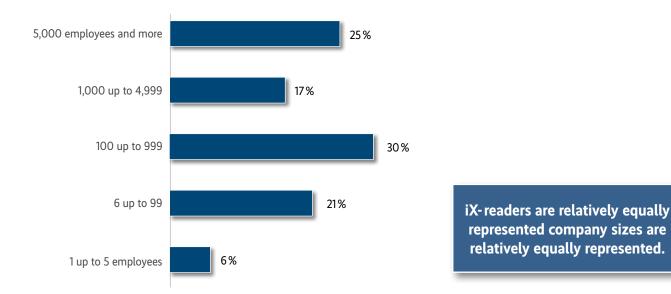

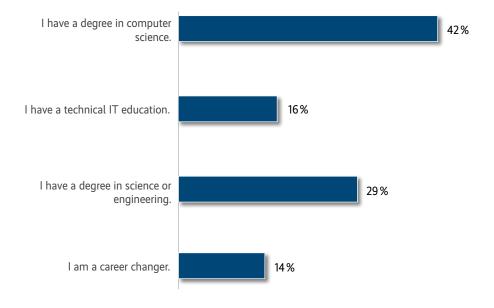

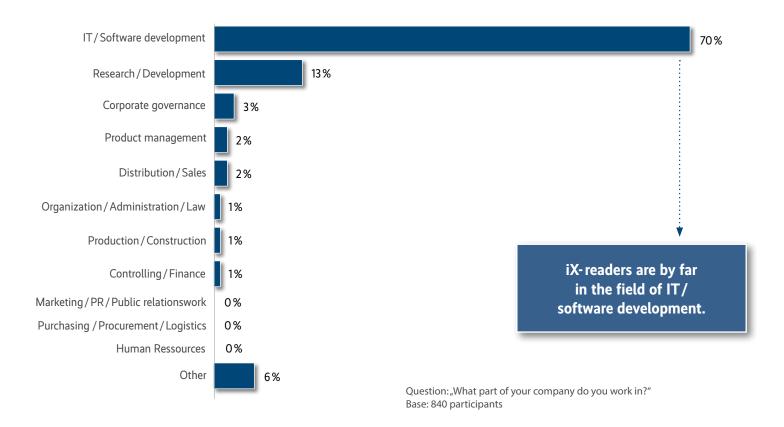

Fields iX-readers work in



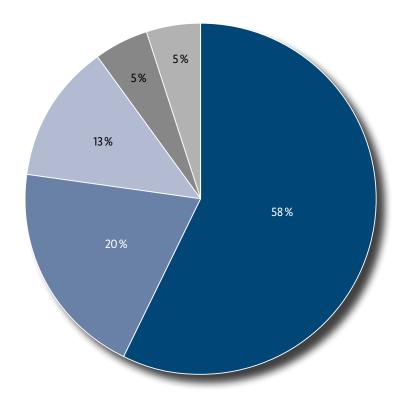
OCCUPATIONAL STATUS



What is your professional position?



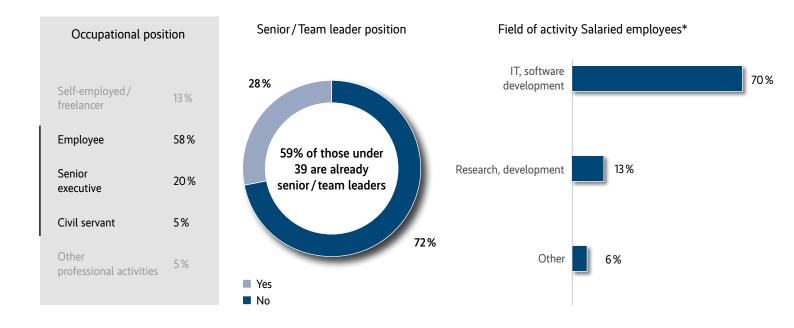

Positions and areas in which iX-readers are active

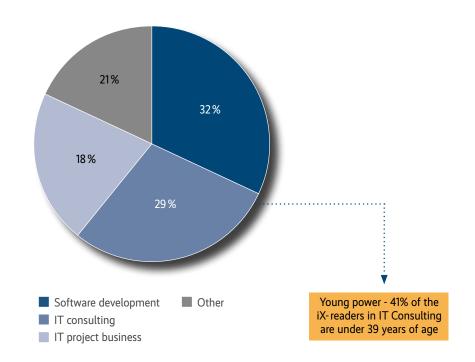

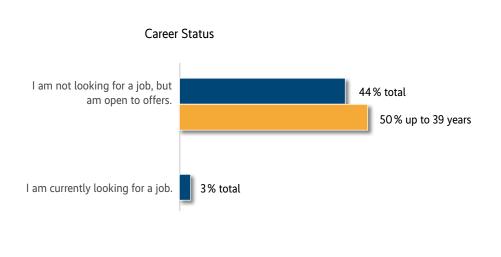

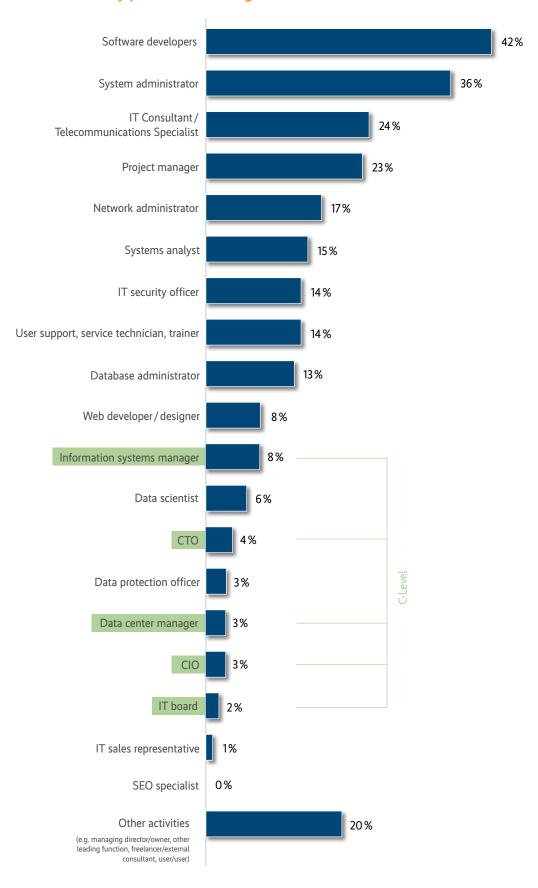

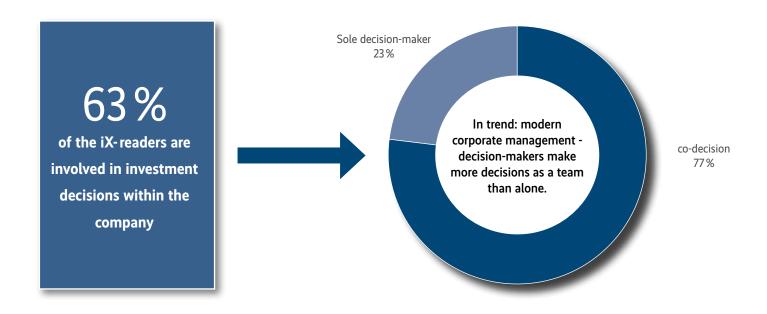

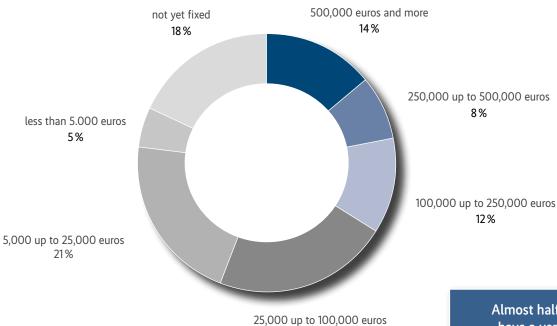

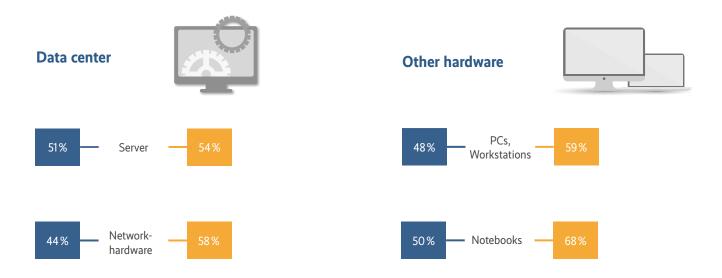

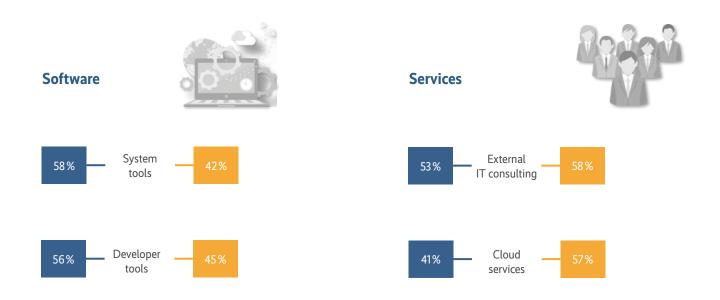
Decision participation and purchase plan at a glance

decision-making participation purchase plan

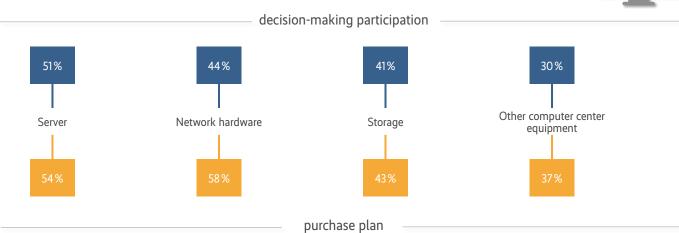

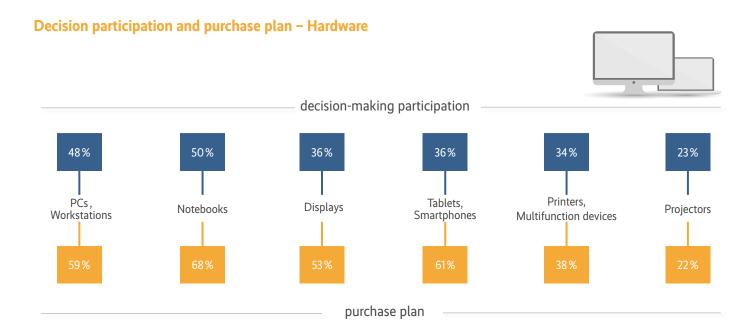

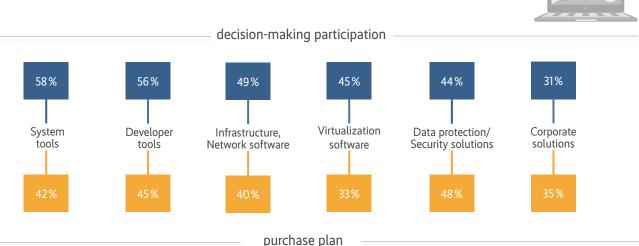

Decision participation and purchase plan – Software



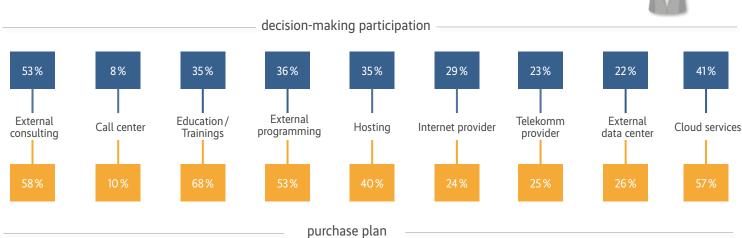

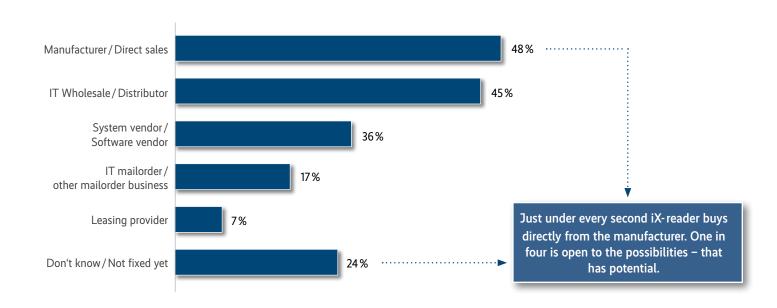
